We were faster in developing visual and technical prototypes, and now want to speed up and boost the technical implementation, to get the portal ready in time for the next round of monitoring surveys.

1. CONTEXT AND RATIONALE

We, as a network, decided in 2019 to embrace open data and to take our datasets from accessible upon request to interactively accessible online and develop a RAY Open Data Portal as part of our 2021–2027 research programme. The development of the portal is normally integrated into the network-wide research projects RAY-MON & RAY-SOC, because the portal will benefit every partner in the network immensely.

We have conducted user interviews with agency and research colleagues in 2023 and 2024, did user interface research, and design and development sprints – and now have a visual and interaction prototype (see the screenshots on the next page). This process was faster and smoother than anticipated, and we now want to use the momentum and accelerate the technical implementation of the portal, so that we can already use it for the next monitoring survey rounds, which will be conducted in autumn 2025.

This is a one-off project: the further development and maintenance of the open data portal will remain an integral part of our RAY-MON and RAY-SOC budgets. We invite all partners to contribute, and also welcome special contributions of partners with the ability and need to boost their TCA or NET spending.




